CLEAN ENERGY EMBASSADORS Protecting the environment and combating climate change through empowering young learners

3rd CEATY Transnational Meeting

As we explained in our first newsletters, the CEATY project is an online climate and energy training initiative designed to achieve the EU's goal of zero net emissions by 2050 through education, public awareness and cooperation.

A lot has happened since our last newsletter where we reported on our meeting in Valencia (Spain), the seminar organised in Ankara (Turkey), which aimed to directly involve students in the development of the curriculum, and, above all, the progress on the project results: development of the training materials and the Clean Energy Ambassadors Toolkit including the digital library and the clean energy game.

After a few months of technical work on the above-mentioned results, the consortium met again in person, this time in Slovenia, in the town of Kranj. LEAG (LOKALNA ENERGETSKA AGENCIJA GORENJSKE) was the hosting partner for this third transnational meeting held on 27-28 March 2024.

At the meeting, the project partners from Bulgaria, Spain, the Netherlands, Slovenia, and Türkiye discussed the following topics of the CEATY project:

- Implementation of the work packages
- Clean Energy Ambassadors Toolkit: Lidi, the technology partner from the Netherlands showed us and explained how the online game and the platform were developed so that we could add our suggestions during the development phase.
- Implementation of the dissemination and exploitation of the project and its results, the partners discussed the need to give more visibility to the project actions, through the use of social media and the website.
- Organisation and logistics for the national dissemination days of the Clean Energy Ambassadors that will take place between September and October 2024.
- Planning of the next project meeting and evaluation of the transnational meeting.

After the face-to-face meeting all partners had to work hard on the revision of the materials and the technological tools, for this, pilot tests were organised, where teachers and students from the different countries were testing the platform and completed a questionnaire so that their suggestions could be implemented later on. Once the pilot tests were done and the changes implemented, the partners have been translating the materials into the different languages of the consortium in order to have a wider reach.

We are currently finalising the last details to have everything ready for the national dissemination days of the project.

Our fourth transnational project meeting will take place in early October in Ankara, Türkiye, where the following day the CEATY Final Conference will be held to promote the project results, which will be hosted by APFL Ankara Pursaklar Science High School.
